

Child Care Benefit Network

The Child Care Benefit Network is a unique service provided through the Carelink program.

The Child Care Benefit Network contracts with area businesses to offer monitored placement service for those employees who need child care. By placing these children in existing child care providers in the community, the Child Care Benefit Network can offer employers and employees both the flexibility and dependability to meet the wide variety of needs required by the local employment pool. The providers who agree to be part of this network also accept ongoing monitoring and support, including (for those providers caring for children in their own homes) involvement with and reimbursements from the USDA Child and Adult Food Program. Families involved with the network receive technical assistance in understanding “good child care” and working with the child care provider to ensure the highest quality services available. Families are also able to access assistance with their child care costs through the benefit network.
